Age	Between 25 and 40 years old as of April 1st, 2024
Academic Background	Possess a Bachelor Degree authorized by the Government of Pakistan or other countries
Work Experience	<ul style="list-style-type: none">▪ CSS/Cadre Officers▪ Federal Ex-Cadre Officers (BPS 17 and above) who have worked at least 3 years after entering public service at the time of application deadline
INELIGIBILITY	A person corresponds to the followings is NOT eligible to apply: <ul style="list-style-type: none">• Those who are currently receiving (or is scheduled to receive) another scholarship (including other scholarships of Japan).• Those who have obtained a master's or higher degrees overseas under the support of foreign scholarship.• Military personnel registered on the active list or person on alternative military service, and also personnel on temporary leave from the active list.
